- Campsites at Mather Campground for any individual planning to be camping on the GCNP South Rim. This will include ALL scouts, and families that indicate on the form they will be staying in the Mather Campground.
- Camping and Backcountry Permits for Scouts and Families planning on being within the Canyon. This is subject to availability from the Back Country Office. If you are not in the A, B, or C Group, and plan to camp within the Grand Canyon, attach a preferred itinerary with this form.
- Room Reservations in Las Vegas for the night of April 28th.
- Meals for the scouts will be managed in A, B, and C Groupings similar to the in-canyon experience trips. In addition, there may be several "group meals" where we will take advantage of local amenities. This may include the first evening at the Grand Canyon (April 22nd), a buffet in Las Vegas (April 28th), and possibly meals "on the road".

In addition to fundamental ground transportation, there may be additional touring trips organized by Vickie Payne and Mike Dolan. They may include tour busses and meals during the day. If you are interested in some of these special trips, I encourage you to get in contact with either of the Rim Activity organizers. You will have to make special arrangements to be involved in these experiences, and they must be booked well in advance.

If you plan to make other meal, travel, and sleeping arrangements, it is important that we know that NOW.
