- Room Reservations in Las Vegas for the night of April 28th.
- Meals for the scouts will be managed in A, B, and C Groupings similar to the in-canyon experience trips. In addition, there may be several "group meals" where we will take advantage of local amenities. This may include the first evening at the Grand Canyon (April 22nd), a buffet in Las Vegas (April 28th), and possibly meals "on the road".

In addition to fundamental ground transportation, there may be additional touring trips organized by Vickie Payne and Mike Dolan. They may include tour busses and meals during the day. If you are interested in some of these special trips. I encourage vou to get in contact with either of the Rim Activity organizers. You will have to make special arrangements to be involved in these experiences, and they must be booked well in advance.
